#### **Tobacco Education Display**

This month upon request, the Santa Rosa County Health Department provided me a few of their education displays and literature. One of the hottest topics on school campuses are tobacco & vaping.

Health department statistics have shown teens cigarette smoking is on a decline however there is a sharp increase in smoking E-cigarettes. In 2014, 12.6% (SRC) and 14.3% (FL) of teens are vaping. In 2016, a large increase 23.7% (SRC) and 24.5% (FL) of teens vape. The last study in 2020 SRC was 27.8% surpassed the state at 26.4%. Vaping education is important since science still does not know all of the dangers.
