- School Safety and Security

He shared that it's been really well received and that he was able to get around to all schools that had 6<sup>th</sup> graders in order to present to all. When he was gone, the resource officer from the school he visited would come here. He also shared about the poster contest being done.
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## Agenda Items

- Request for Approval SAC Funds
  - Request for \$144 for educational support staff for 3 hours each at \$12 per hour for parent engagement/STEAM night. Elena Davis motioned and Aaron Jacobson for the 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Request for \$2,100 to cover the cost for 20 instructional personnel for 7 hours each at \$15 per hour for Progress Monitoring/Data Chats over the summer of 2022 at a date TBD. Mr. Lowrimore shared how the FSA process is going away and what assessment may look like next year from what the Governor has put in place. This will give teachers the opportunity to look over the data into the next year. Motion from Jennifer Letavish and 2<sup>nd</sup> from Rebecca Brewer.
- Accreditation
  - District did do very well. All those that participated had very good things to say, but we do have a few things we can focus on. A lot of information surrounding data and many things that we are involved in right now.
- Parent Engagement/STEAM night success
  - We had about 250 students come. It was nice to have people back in the building. Everyone was appreciative and everyone had a great job. Jennifer Hensley led the charge and she did a very good job. Lead on into next year and looking forward to more opportunities.
- FSA Writing
  - First week in April for FSA Writing. We will be administering writing to about 900 students. 7<sup>th</sup> grade is Monday with 8<sup>th</sup> Grade on Tuesday. Both of those are on computers. 6<sup>th</sup> grade is still paper based and will be on Friday.
  - FSA and EOCs will be tested will be in May. When we wrap up we'll have a few days before semester exams
  - End of the year wraps up May 25<sup>th</sup> before Memorial Day.
- High School Visits
  - GBHS will visit our 8<sup>th</sup> graders on April 11th
  - NHS will visit on April 12<sup>th</sup> and will have their parent night that night.
  - We are focusing a lot on getting ready for next year. We were able to keep our staff and did not lose any units. We had the job hiring fair for the district on Saturday. It was a really neat experience and we were able to hire a teacher during the event. We are waiting on a few more spots to be released, and we'll be hiring a few more spots.
